Soldiers in the ranks of private first class through sergeant first class (regardless of "Y" or "N") who hold a critical skill or special critical skill and who are more than 18 months from their ETS and within 120 days after redeployment may be entitled to a bonus in Table 2, provided they re-up for the Regular Army Re-enlistment Option.

Deployed SRB: Soldiers, regardless of ETS who are serving on active duty in Afghanistan, Iraq, Kuwait and Djibouti may be eligible for a lump-sum bonus listed in Table 4.
